

# The Days of Noah

## Matthew 24, Genesis 4, 6

<sup>37</sup> "When the Son of Man returns, it will be like it was in Noah's day. <sup>38</sup> In those days before the flood, the people were enjoying banquets and parties and weddings right up to the time Noah entered his boat.

<sup>39</sup> People didn't realize what was going to happen until the flood came and swept them all away. That is the way it will be when the Son of Man comes. Matthew 24:37-39

## Seven Signs of the Days of Noah Compared to Today They were Days of.....

**1. Secular Philosophy**—<sup>5</sup> The LORD observed the extent of human wickedness on the earth, and He saw that everything they thought or imagined [Hb. "to fashion as a potter"] was consistently and totally evil. <sup>6</sup> So the LORD was sorry He had ever made them and put them on the earth. It broke His heart. Genesis 6:5-6

**2. Scientific Progress**— Genesis 4-6 "men of renown" "built a city" "expert in forging tools"  
Don't think these were backward cavemen days!

**3. Social Plagues**—<sup>11</sup> Now God saw that the earth had become **corrupt** and was filled with violence. <sup>12</sup> God observed all this corruption in the world, for everyone on earth was corrupt. <sup>13</sup> So God said to Noah, "I have decided to destroy all living creatures, for they have filled the earth with violence. Yes, I will wipe them all out along with the earth!" Genesis 6:11-13

Violence, Murder, Revenge, Polygamy, etc.

**4. Sexual Perversion**—<sup>28</sup> "And the world will be as it was in the days of Lot. People went about their daily business—eating and drinking, buying and selling, farming and building—<sup>29</sup> until the morning Lot left Sodom. Then fire and burning sulfur rained down from heaven and destroyed them all. <sup>30</sup> Yes, it will be 'business as usual' right up to the day when the Son of Man is revealed. Luke 17:28-30

Romans 1 \_\_\_\_\_ is built into sin!

**5. Selfish Prosperity**—<sup>49</sup> Sodom's sins were pride, gluttony, and laziness, while the poor and needy suffered outside her door. <sup>50</sup> She was proud and committed detestable sins, so I wiped her out, as you have seen. Ezekiel 16:49-50

6. **Solemn Preaching**—<sup>13</sup> *So God said to Noah, “I have decided to destroy all living creatures, for they have filled the earth with violence. Yes, I will wipe them all out along with the earth!*

Genesis 6:13

<sup>5</sup> *And God did not spare the ancient world—except for Noah and the seven others in his family. Noah warned the world of God’s righteous judgment.*

2 Peter 2:5

<sup>14</sup> *Enoch, who lived in the seventh generation after Adam, prophesied about these people. He said, “Listen! The Lord is coming with countless thousands of His holy ones <sup>15</sup> to execute judgment on the people of the world. He will convict every person of all the ungodly things they have done and for all the insults that ungodly sinners have spoken against Him.”*

7. **Sudden Panic**—<sup>39</sup> *People didn’t realize what was going to happen until the flood came and swept them all away.*

Matthew 24:39

*After seven days, the waters of the flood came and covered the earth. When Noah was 600 years old, on the seventeenth day of the second month, all the underground waters erupted from the earth, and the rain fell in mighty torrents from the sky. <sup>12</sup> The rain continued to fall for forty days and forty nights*




