1. The Words Jesus Would Say (1)

My God, My God, why have You forsaken Me? Why are You so far from helping Me, [Matthew 27:46]

2. The Supernatural _____ . (2)

O My God, I cry in the daytime, but You do not hear; And in the night season, and am not silent. [Matt. 27:45]

3. The Scorn and the Ridicule (7-13)

"He trusted in the LORD, let Him rescue Him; Let Him deliver Him, since He delights in Him!" [Matt. 27:39ff]

Note: These prophecies were fulfilled by the _____ of Jesus not His Followers!

4. Water from His side (14)

I am poured out like water, [John 19:34]

5. Bones out of Joint (14)

And all My bones are out of joint; [Nature of the Crucifixion]

6. Severe Thirst (15)

My strength is dried up like a potsherd, And My tongue clings to My jaws; [John 19:28]

7. _____ of the Crucifixion (15-16)

You have brought Me to the dust of death. For dogs have surrounded Me; The congregation of the wicked has enclosed Me. They pierced My hands and My feet;

"dogs" = Gentiles congregation = Jewish Council You = Father

8. Stripped of Clothing, Gamble for Clothing (17-18)

I can count all My bones. They look and stare at Me. ¹⁸ They divide My garments among them, And for My clothing they cast lots. [Matthew 27:28, 36, 35]
