3. The <u>Satisfaction</u> of the Cross

¹⁸ Christ suffered for our sins once for all time. He never sinned, but he died for sinners to bring you safely home to God. He suffered physical death, but he was raised to life in the Spirit.

4. The Salvation of the Cross

Sin separates us from the Holy God! Cross reconciles us with the Holy God!
